# SAMI BITUMEN TECHNOLOGIES – KWINANA BITUMEN TERMINAL CIVIL & BUILDING WORKS

**A new industrial plant to service WA's road infrastructure needs**

In order to better service the Western Australian market, Sami Bitumen Technologies, a member of the French Colas Group of Companies, required a second import and processing terminal in the Fremantle Ports area, to support its existing operations in North Fremantle. Following an open competitive tender process, CareyMC were awarded the contract to manage the construction of civil infrastructure and building at the new Kwinana site.

Our services included:

- Management of Asbestos Contaminated Materials (ACM) which existed on the site
- Installation of underground service culverts, conduits and drawpits.
- Construction of site drainage system including infiltration ponds, flush pits, manholes and pipework.
- Concrete foundations, slabs and bund walls
- Fabrication and installation of loading gantry steelwork
- Construction and fitout of the MCC building

CareyMC staff assisting the design consultants and the owner to resolve and rationalise constructability details and reduce the overall concrete requirements. The project also allowed us to further develop the career of one of our Indigenous trainee labourers; with the project providing the opportunity and funding for his non slewing crane operators licence.
